Virginia Aviation Museum in Richmond to close June 30th

The museum, home to a collection of 38 aircraft, will charge no admission until it closes June 30. The museum has operated on Richmond International Airport property since 1991.

The museum says in a statement that the building that houses the museum, a hangar that was built in 1987, has "reached the end of its useful life." Museum spokeswoman Chrissy Caldwell says attempts to find a new structure have been unsuccessful and problems with climate control and the structure itself has forced the closure.

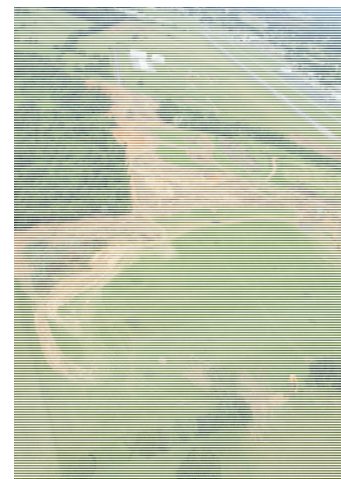
